

EAR TAPING (THE FINAL SETTING METHOD)

THANKS TO CHERYL CATES OF ENCORE BOXERS FOR THIS METHOD

This method is great for setting the tips of lazy ears

Supplies

3M Transpore

(a clear surgical tape)

The white cloth tape used for the other taping methods- will work- it may not last as long as the surgical tape

For each ear- you will need approximately 5 inches of tape- this tape tears easily and is very sticky!



I am offering these tips to offer one way to get your dog's ears to stand- just by following these tips does NOT mean your dog's ears will stand. Please feel free to email me with any questions or comments.



Place the end of the tape on the ear- at an angle..so as to go up the ear and then it will naturally angle back down – to give support for the tips. Tear off the remaining end



Here is the final look..

You can keep this tape on for several days- the ears can breathe very well with this tape- but if the weather is very hot or humid, you may see moisture under the tape- you may need to replace the tape more frequently.

Coco's ears are done- tips are strong and bases are solid. She was the best model for holding still- despite being less than thrilled!
